



Boodskap van Cobus Dowry Minister van Plaaslike Regering

GMIP OORSIG - 2002-2003

Indie 2002/2003 finansiële jaar het die Departement van Plaaslike Regering 'n bedrag van R142,4 miljoen deur GMIP gekoördineer. In die befondsing van GMIP projekte dra 'n munisipaliteit ook tot 'n projek by en is die voltooië waarde van 'n projek groter as die GMIP bydrae. 175 projekte is goedgekeur met 'n totale waarde van R380 miljoen waarvan die GMIP waarde R188 miljoen is.

Gedurende die afgelope jaar het 149 projekte met 'n GMIP waarde van R159,91 miljoen 'n aanvang geneem terwyl 95 projekte met 'n GMIP waarde van R64 miljoen voltooi is. Getrou aan die karakter en doel van GMIP om trotse gemeenskappe te bou deur die voorsiening van infrastruktuur, is 71 klein en middelslag kontrakteurs gebruik wat werk onderneem het met 'n waarde van R23 miljoen en is 225 313 persoons dae van werk geskep.

Na aanleiding van al die voorafgaande is die Wes -Kaap weereens erken as een van die beste provinsies wat lewering betref met die GMIP program.

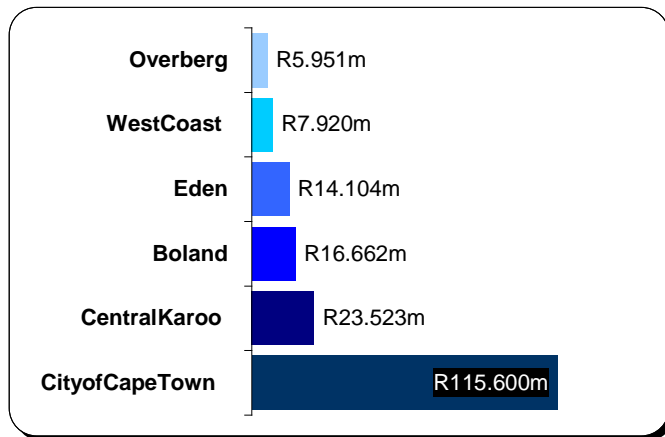

CMIP ALLOCATIONS 2003/2004

CMIP Allocation for the infrastructure projects for 2003/04 financial year

The following figures were supplied by the National Programme Manager. The 2003 Division of Revenue Bill is due to be gazetted during April 2003.



These amounts include allocations targeted at URP and ISRDP nodes as well as Labour Intensive Projects.

Programmeperformancetargets

The National Programme Manager (NPM) has set a number of Performance Targets that impact upon all role players involved in the CMIP. Some of the key targets are represented below:

- 50% of each District Municipalities' 2003/04 allocation is to be expended by October 2003, failing which the NPM reserves the right to re-allocate CMIP funds.
- Cash flow estimates and actual expenditures should not deviate by more than 25% for any given month.
- Sufficient business plans must be submitted to the Provincial Programme Manager by April 2003 to commit the CMIP allocations for 2003/04.
- The date of submission for Business Plans to take up your full allocation up to March 2006 is 31 October 2003.
- 50 SMMEs to be employed on CMIP projects in the Western Cape during 2003/04.
- 30% of all employment opportunities created on CMIP projects to be women.

'n Bedrag van R5,6m is aan die 2003/04 CMIP kapasiteitsbouprogram toegeken. Die CMIP Provinsiale Programbestuurder het op 'n breë grondslag beraadslaag om sodoende die kapasiteitsboubehoeftes wat binne die CMIP raamwerk vir Kapasiteitsbouval, aantesprek. 'n Besigheidsplan is voorbereien by die Nasionale Programbestuurder vir goedkeuring ingedien.

The main areas of the proposed Capacity Building programme are:

- The annual CMIP workshops attended by all Municipalities
- Targeted training for Municipal Employees in the field of:
 - i. Electrical services
 - ii. Solid Waste Management
 - iii. Project Management
 - iv. Water and Sanitation
 - v. Driver Training
 - vi. Managing LED Projects
- GIS and GIS Applications
- Infrastructure Master Planning
- Training of SMMEs.
