# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE COUNCIL OF HERITAGE WESTERN CAPE AND THE NATIONAL HERITAGE COUNCIL

Members of the public are invited to nominate candidates to serve on the Council of Heritage Western Cape, a provincial heritage resources authority of the Western Cape, for a period of three years.

Heritage Western Cape is charged with the responsibility to conserve, promote and manage heritage resources of the Western Cape.

Its mandate is governed by the National Heritage Resources Act, 1999 (Act 25 of 1999) and the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act 1 of 1999).

Nominated members will also be considered to be nominated by the MEC as the provincial representative on the National Heritage Council. The mandate of the National Heritage Council is governed by the National Heritage Act, 1999 (No 11 of 1999).

### REQUIREMENTS:

Nominees must –

- (a) Be South African citizens
- (b) Be permanently resident in the Western Cape
- (c) Have knowledge of and qualifications, experience or interests in subjects related to heritage resources management.

Members of the Council will be appointed by the MEC in accordance with the principles of transparency and representivity.
