4. Be a resident of the Western Cape.
5. Be committed to developing language capacity in the province.

**Please note that the bursaries are awarded under the following conditions:**

1. Submission of a fully completed application form and additional documents outlined above.
2. Submission of proof of registration at the tertiary institution of your choice before payment of the first instalment of the bursary to the tertiary institution.
3. Submission of satisfactory progress reports, before the payment of the second and final instalment of the bursary and upon completion of the study.
4. In the case of full-time students a progress report is to be submitted at the end of the first semester and upon completion of the study.
5. In the case of part-time students a progress report is to be submitted at the end of the

first year of study and upon completion of the study. 6. Signing a contract with the Western Cape Language Committee.
