◆ Priority will be accorded to previously disadvantaged communities ◆ Projects must be arts, culture and heritage related ◆ There should be good evidence of beneficiaries skills, potential or ability to learn ◆ Products and services of the project must be of good quality and should be marketable both locally and abroad ◆ Projects should have the potential to be self sustaining ◆ Projects must comply with legislation(s) where applicable ◆ Projects must engage in fair trade ◆ Projects should be located in poverty nodes and provincial priority areas ◆ Projects should be community driven and owned or directly benefit the community in terms of either jobs, training or partnerships ◆ Projects using raw materials should ensure that the resources are eco friendly and utilize environmentally sustainable harvesting or utilization patterns ◆ Projects should have intention to establish a small business or business units for the creation of employment ◆ Projects should have potential to support and promote tourism ◆ Projects should have unique indigenous production ◆ Women, youth and the disabled should be prioritized ◆ Agents, consultants or any other service provider cannot be the beneficiaries ◆ Projects must support government programmes in line with Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP), Accelerated Shared Growth Initiative-South Africa (ASGI-SA), Provincial Growth Development Strategy (PGDS), Integrated Development Plan (IDP), Integrated Sustainable Rural Development Programme (ISRDP) and Urban Renewal Programme (URP).
