	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be arts and culture related • Harness project events to contribute to economic growth, job creation and poverty alleviation • Should have a strong emphasis on youth development • Should be integrated through prioritising the needs for gender balance, disability and cultural diversity • Should be specific in terms of training and developing the art form • Should operate within the following fields/genres: Dance, Drama, Music, Visual arts, Literary arts, Crafts and Theatre • Project deliverables should be clearly spelt out • Should clearly indicate the target group that will benefit (eg youth) • Should indicate how the project will be monitored and evaluated
